

2020 Fleet Awards

Selection Criteria & Rules of Eligibility

KEY DATES

Submissions are due no later than **12.00pm Monday 2 March 2020**. Any submissions received after this date will not be considered.

The **2020 Awards** will be presented at 2020 Fleet Conference & Exhibition Dinner in **Melbourne**, on TBC.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to members and non-members of the Association
- Self-nominations are accepted
- Open to any individual who is directly employed in a fleet management role within a private company, utility, government department, council, or not-for-profit organisation operating in Australasia with the exception of employees of vehicle manufacturers and Fleet Management Organisations
- Nominations for multiple awards will be accepted
- Members of AfMA's Board and their employing organisation may not be nominated
- If a nominee has won in one of the categories, they are ineligible to nominate for that category for 5 years. However they can nominate in the two other categories.

SELECTION CRITERIA

To be considered for the **Fleet Manager of the Year Award**, the individual must demonstrate:

- Innovative and creative Fleet Management strategy
- Improvements to efficiency and/or financial performance
- Measurable outcomes from implementation with supporting data

To be considered for the **Fleet Environment Award**, the organisation must demonstrate:

- Innovative and creative Fleet Management strategy for improving environmental performance and reducing carbon footprint
- Reductions in emissions and environmental impact and/or financial performance
- Measurable outcomes from implementation with supporting data
- Future planning strategies

To be considered for the **Fleet Safety Award**, the organisation must demonstrate:

- Innovative and creative Fleet Management strategy for improving fleet safety outcomes
- Reduction in the number of crashes/injuries/insurance claims/etc
- Measurable outcomes from implementation with supporting data
- Positive financial outcomes for the organisation from improvement of fleet safety policy
- Future planning strategies

JUDGING CRITERIA

All submissions are judged by an independent panel of industry experts. The criteria for judging includes, but is not limited to, originality and creativity, benefit to the organisation as a whole, demonstrable outcomes resulting from implementation and applicability to other fleet operations.

All submissions are to be submitted electronically using the prescribed template with supporting documentation attached.
